

- You want to be able to improve your communication and be more comfortable around death and dying issues.

- You have a friend or family member who is in early dementia, and you want to ask them their wishes before it's too late.
- · You want to start coming to grips with your own mortality.
- You have a life-threatening illness and want others to know your wishes.
- You don't have a life-threatening illness, but you realize things do happen and you want to cover your bases for practical reasons.
- You want to take some of the stress out of end-of-life care for the ones you love. This book will let others know your wishes, and will decrease the amount of their stress over the practical details so your loved ones can focus on what is really important.




